Material:

- crochet hook size 2.5
- wool in shades of white, black , grey
- fiberfill
- 2 eyes of glass or plastic
- sewing needle
- black and white felt
- pipe cleaner

Size:

The Baby Lemur is about 11 cm (4,3 inches) tall

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet in each stitch

inc - two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together

dc – double crochet

sl st - slip stitch

rep - repeat until end of round

BLO – back loops only

FLO – front loops only

Note:

Unless indicated otherwise, parts are worked in rounds for the Lemur. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring. It is important to mark the beginning of your round.

Legs (2 x) and ...

2 ch in color grey

R 01 6 x sc in 2nd ch from hook 6

R 02 sc, inc, rep 9

R 03 sc in each stitch 9

R 04 sc in each stitch 9

R 05 sc in each stitch 9

Finish the first leg with sl st, cut the thread.

when the second leg is finished, connect both legs with sl st and we start from there with the

R 06 sc in each stitch 18

R 07 2 x sc, inc, rep 24

R 08 - R 14 sc in each stitch 24

R 15 2 x sc, dec, rep stuff the legs and the body 18

R 16	sc, dec, rep	12
R 17	2 x sc, dec, rep	9
sl st, cut the thread		

Head

2 ch in color black

R 01	6 x sc in 2nd ch from hook	6
R 02	sc, inc, rep	9
R 03	sc in each stitch, change color to white	9
R 04	BLO: 2 x sc, inc, rep	12
R 05	sc in each stitch	12
R 06	2 x sc, inc, rep	16
R 07	3 x sc, inc, rep	20
R 08	4 x sc, inc, rep	24
R 09	6 x (sc, inc), 12 x sc	30
R 10	sc in each stitch	30
R 11	4 x sc, inc, rep	36
R 12	6 x sc, change color to grey, 9 x sc, change color to white, 21 x sc	36
R 13	2 x sc, dec, sc, sc, change color to grey, 10 x sc, change color to white, 7 x sc, dec, 11 x sc	34
R 14	dec, 20 x sc, dec, 10 x sc	32
R 15	2 x sc, dec, rep	24
R 16	2 x sc, dec, rep	18



Before you finish the head, the safety eyes must be attached.

Cut out an oval piece from black felt. Put the safety eyes through the felt and attach the felt with the eyes on the head. Pay attention to the right position of the eyes.

R 17	sc, dec, rep	stuff the head	12
R 18	dec, rep		6
sl st, cut the thread and sew the opening.			

Arm (2x)

2 ch in color grey

R 01	6 x sc in 2nd ch from hook	6
R 02 - R 08	sc in each stitch	6
R 09	ch, 3 x dc, ch	
sl st, cut the thread. Don't stuff the arms.		

Ear (2x)

2 ch in color white

R 01	6 x sc in 2nd ch from hook	6
R 02	inc in each stitch	12
R 03	12 x sc, sl st	12

Cut the thread. Cut out an oval piece of black felt in the shape of the ear and sew the felt piece inside the ear.

Tail

2 ch in color black

R 01 6 x sc in 2nd ch from hook 6

R 02 sc in each stitch 6

R 03 sc in each stitch, change color to white 6

R 04 - R 06 sc in each stitch, change color to black 6

R 07 - ... R 36 the tail has a total of 36 rows. Change the color after every third row

Pull a piece of pipe cleaner inside the tail.

Belly

Cut out an oval piece of white felt and sew it on the body.



Finishing



Sew the completed ears to the head. Sew the arms, head and the tail to the body. Pay attention to the correct position. Before you start to sew, fix them with pins and find the correct position. Small hint: Even if it means more work, it is better to sew the parts for the Amigurumi with a cotton thread in the same color. If a part is not on the right place, and you find this out at the end looking at your Amigurumi, it will be easier for you, to correct that.
