# Panda Fu Hu

Crochet Pattern

**Material:**

- crochet hook size 2.5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr in shades of white and black
- fiberfill
- safety eyes 9 mm
- sewing needle
- a small black piece of felt for the nose or you can just embroider the nose

**Size:**

The Panda Fu Hu is about 12 cm tall (4,72 inches)

**Abbreviations:**

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet  
(or a dc, hdc ...) in each stitch

inc - make two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

rep - repeat until end of round

sl st - slip stitch

**sc with color change:** change the color on this sc (when you make this single crochet stitch, grab the new color of your wool and pull it through the two loops on your hook).

**Note:**

Unless indicated otherwise, the parts for Fu Hu are worked in rounds. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring.

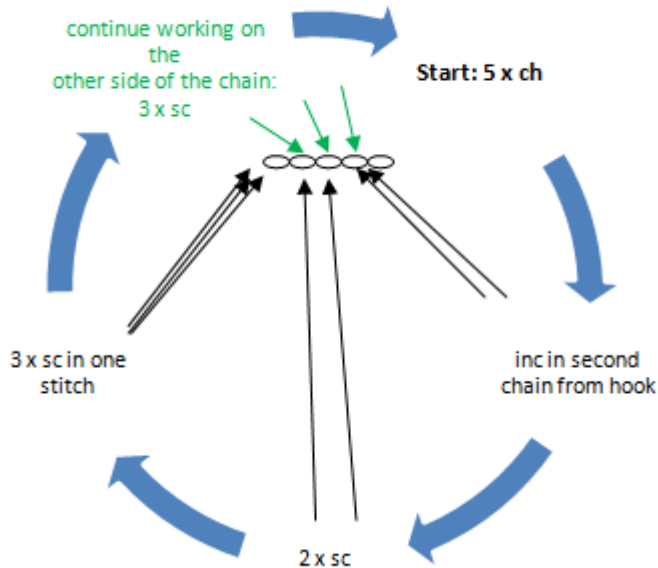
Make the arms, legs and the ears before you start with the body, because they are crocheted to the body. Also the crocheted eyes must be finished before you close the head, because the safety eyes are inserted through them and then to the head. The rows should be marked with a thread.

Don't remove the thread marks on the legs, you need them for orientation when you crochet the legs to the body.

## Legs (2 x)

5 ch in color black

R 01 inc in second ch from hook, 2 x sc, 3sc in one stitch, continue working on the other side of the chain: 3 x sc, see drawing **10**



R 02 2 x inc, 2 x sc, 3 x inc, 2 x sc, inc **16**

R 03 sc in each stitch **16**

R 04 5 x sc, 5 x dec, sc **11**

R 05 4 x sc, 3 x dec, sc **8**

R 06 **sc with color change** to white, 4 x sc, dec, sc, stuff the foot **7**

R 07 – R 11 sc in each stitch **7**

sl st, cut the thread. Don't stuff the legs. Leave the thread mark inside the leg, you need them later for orientation, when you crochet the leg to the body.

## Arms (2 x)

2 ch in color white

R 01 6 x sc in second ch from hook **6**

R 02 2 x sc, inc, rep **8**

R 03 sc in each stitch **8**

R 04 2 x sc, dec, rep **6**

R 05 sc in each stitch, stuff the hand **6**

R 06 – 09 sc in each stitch **6**

R 10 5 x sc, **sc with color change** to black **6**

R 11 sc in each stitch **6**

R 12 sc in each stitch **6**

sl st, cut the thread. Don't stuff the arm.

## Eyes (2 x)

2 ch in color black

R 01 6 x sc in second ch from hook 6

R 02 3 x sc in one stitch, 2 x sl st, rep 10

Cut the thread and sew it

## Body and head

2 ch in color white

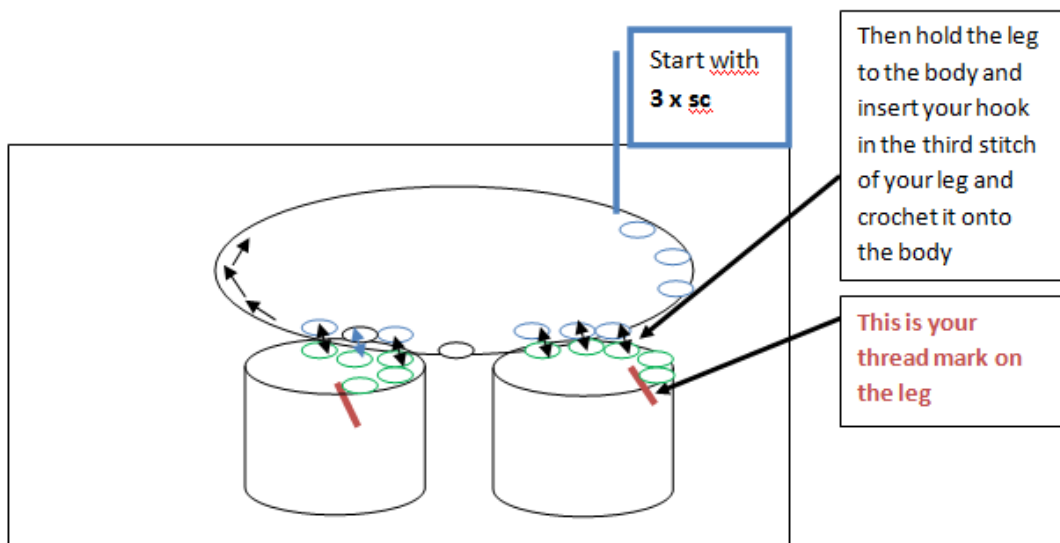
R 01 6 x sc in second ch from hook 6

R 02 inc in each stitch 12

R 03 sc, inc, rep 18

R 04 **3 x sc**, then start to crochet the leg to the body.

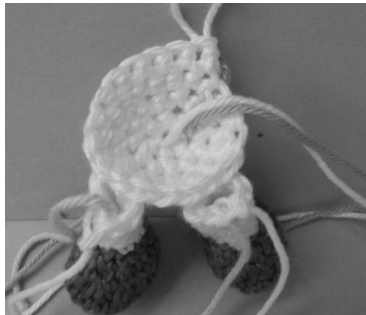
Where to start on the leg: count back three stitches from your thread mark (see picture), hold the leg to the body and crochet the stitches of the leg and the body together. See the picture and the drawing underneath.





crochet the stitches of the leg and the body together with **3 x sc**  
now only over the body: sc,  
crochet the stitches of the second leg and the body together with **3 x sc**  
and then only over the body: 8 x sc

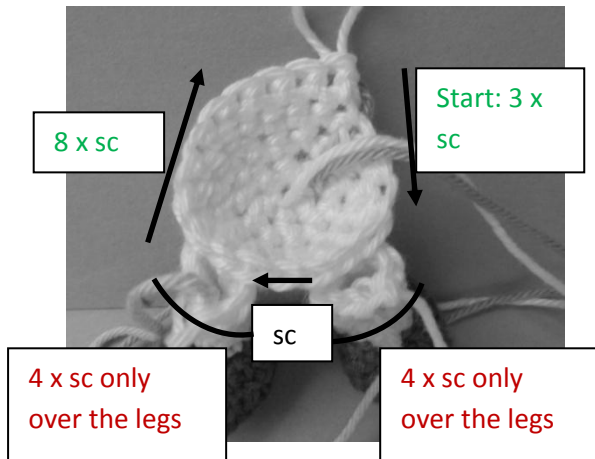
That's how the body looks like after R 04. The legs were crocheted to the body.

R 05

**3 x sc,**  
crochet only over the stitches of the leg: **4 x sc,**  
now over the body: sc,  
and then crochet over the stitches of the second leg: **4 x sc**  
and again over the body: 8 x sc

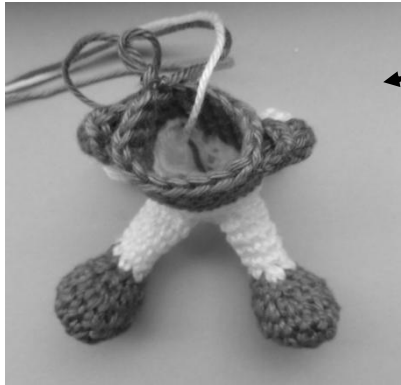

Row 05:



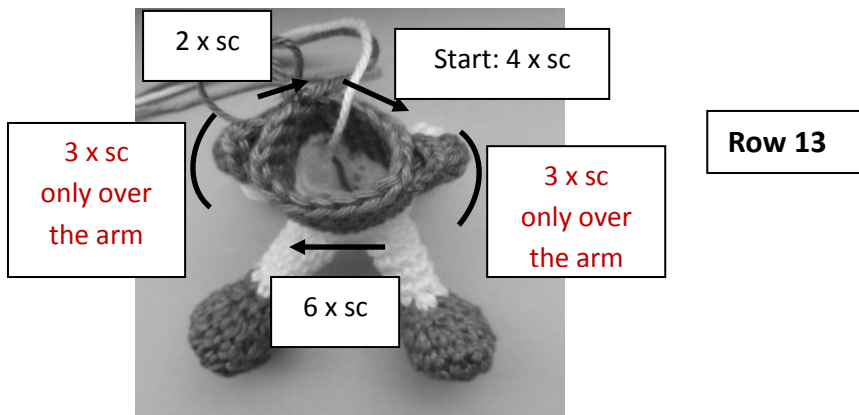
... and this is how it looks like after the 5<sup>th</sup> row

R 06	7 x sc, dec, 8 x sc, dec, sc	<b>18</b>
R 07	16 x sc, <b>sc with color change</b> to black, sc	<b>18</b>
R 08 – R 11	sc in each stitch	<b>18</b>
R 12	4 x sc, now crochet the arm and the body together with 3 x sc <u>only on the body with 6 x sc</u> then crochet the second arm and the body together with 3 x sc <u>only on the body with 2 x sc</u>	<b>18</b>



Body after R 12, in which the arms were crocheted to the body.

R 13	4 x sc, now crochet only over the arm: <b>3 x sc</b> 6 x sc, crochet only over the second arm: <b>3 x sc</b> 2 x sc	<b>18</b>
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R 14	17 x sc, <b>sc with color change</b> to white	<b>18</b>
R 15	sc, dec, rep, stuff the body	<b>12</b>
R 16	sc in each stitch	<b>12</b>
R 17	inc in each stitch	<b>24</b>
R 18	2 x sc, inc, rep	<b>32</b>
R 19	3 x sc, inc, rep	<b>40</b>

R 20 – R 23	sc in each stitch	<b>40</b>
R 24	23 x sc, insert a <b>thread marker</b> for the first eye, 8 x sc, insert a <b>thread marker</b> for the second eye, 9 x sc	<b>40</b>
R 25	sc in each stitch	<b>40</b>
R 26	sc in each stitch	<b>40</b>
R 27	3 x sc, dec, rep, Now, <i>put in the safety eyes, , see the pictures</i>	<b>32</b>



Insert the safety eyes through the crocheted eyes



Then insert the eyes to the head, where you have marked the position with a **thread marker**.

R 28	6 x sc, dec, rep	<b>28</b>
R 29	5 x sc, dec, rep	<b>24</b>
R 30	2 x sc, dec, rep, stuff the head	<b>18</b>
R 31	sc, dec, rep	<b>12</b>
R 32	dec, rep	<b>6</b>

sl st, cut the thread and sew the opening

### Ears

2 ch in color black

R 01	5 x sc in second ch from hook	<b>5</b>
R 02	inc in each stitch	<b>10</b>
R 03	sc in each stitch	<b>10</b>
R 04	sc in each stitch	<b>10</b>
R 05	sl st in each stitch	<b>10</b>

cut the thread and sew it

### Muzzle

2 ch in color white

R 01	6 x sc in second ch from hook	<b>6</b>
R 02	sc, inc, rep	<b>9</b>
R 03	3 x sc, inc, 4 x sc, inc	<b>11</b>
R 04	4 x sc, inc, 5 x sc, inc	<b>13</b>

sl st, cut the thread and sew it

## Finishing



Cut the nose out of a piece of black felt or embroider it. Embroider the mouth on the muzzle and stuff everything with a little bit of fiberfill. Pin the ears and the muzzle to the head and sew them. Sew the black part of the eyes to the head.
