The little chair

Crochet pattern

Material:

- Margarine box or similar plastic material, I have used an plastic folder
- crochet hook size 2.5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr
- fiberfill
- sewing needle

Size: The chair has a height of about 8 cm (3,15 inches)

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet
(or a dc, hdc ...) in each stitch

inc - make two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

rep - repeat until end of round

sl st - slip stitch

BLO – back loops only

Note:

Unless indicated otherwise, the parts are worked in rounds. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring.

Make the chair legs before you start with the seat, because they are crocheted on the seat. The rows should be marked with a thread.

Chair legs (4 x)

2 ch

R 01	6 x sc in second ch from hook	6
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R 02	inc in each stitch	12
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R 03	sc in each stitch	12
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R 04	6 x dec	6
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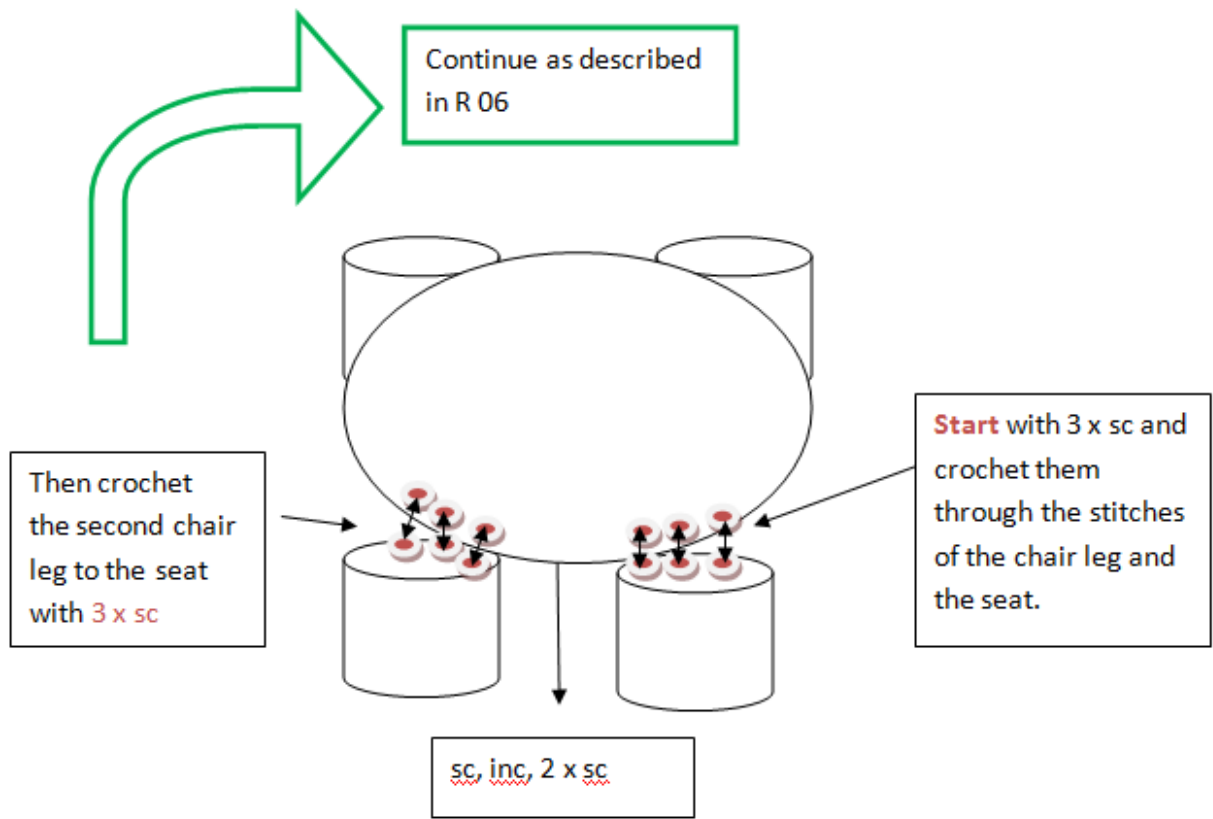
R 05	sc in each stitch	6
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sl st, cut the thread, stuff the chair legs firmly.



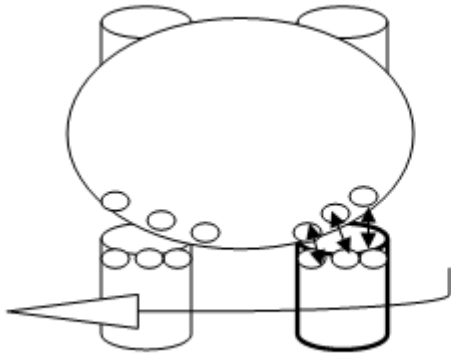
Seat

2 ch		
R 01	6 x sc in second ch from hook	6
R 02	inc in each stitch	12
R 03	sc, inc, rep	18
R 04	2 x sc, inc, rep	24
R 05	3 x sc, inc, rep	30
R 06	now we crochet the chair legs to the seat: 3 x sc on the chair leg and the seat, sc, inc, 2 x sc 3 x sc on the chair leg and the seat, inc, 3 x sc, inc 3 x sc on the chair leg and the seat, sc, inc, 2 x sc 3 x sc on the chair leg and the seat, inc, 3 x sc, inc	36



- R 07 3 x sc crochet them only on the outside of the seat leg, see picture
 Then make 2 x sc, inc, 2 x sc
 3 x sc on the outside of the seat leg,
 inc, 5 x sc, inc
 3 x sc on the outside of the seat leg,
 2 x sc inc, 2 x sc
 3 x sc on the outside of the seat leg,
 inc, 5 x sc, inc

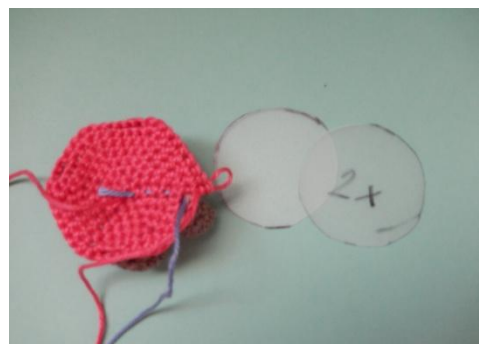
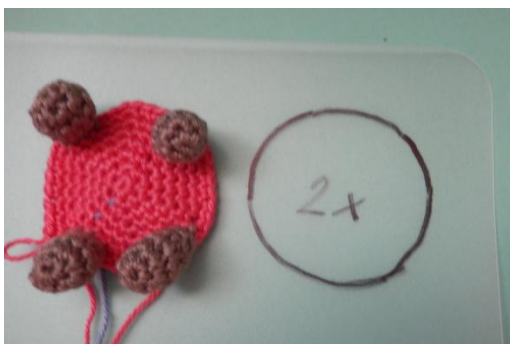


In R 07 crochet over the stitches of the outside of the chair leg. After that row all of your chair legs are crocheted on the seat.

- R 08 **BLO:** sc in each stitch 42
 R 09 sc in each stitch 42
 R 10 sc in each stitch 42
 R 11 sc in each stitch 42

To make the chair stable, we need to insert two pieces of plastic. You can cut this piece out of margarine boxes or plastic folders. I have used a plastic folder.

After row 11, put the seat part on the plastic, draw it on your plastic material and cut it out. There are two parts needed. Put the plastic parts to the side, later we place them inside the seat.



- R 12 **BLO:** 5 x sc, dec, rep 36
 R 13 4 x sc, dec, rep 30
 R 14 3 x sc, dec, rep 24

If necessary, stuff the chair legs firmly once again



R 15 2 x sc, dec, rep

Insert the first round plastic part, then lightly stuff your seat with fiberfill, the seat should not bulge, then insert your second plastic part. **18**



R 16 sc, dec, rep **12**

R 17 dec, rep **6**

sl st, cut the thread and leave a long piece for sewing.

Sew the opening and go with your thread through the top of your seat to the bottom, tighten it slightly, sew the thread.



Backrest

24 x ch close it with a sl st to a ring

R 01 3 x sc, inc, rep **30**

R 02 4 x sc, inc, rep **36**

R 03 5 x sc, inc, rep **42**

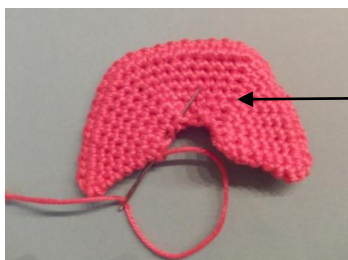
R 04 6 x sc, inc, rep **48**

R 05 7 x sc, inc, rep **54**

R 06 8 x sc, inc, rep **60**

Fold the circle in half, then crochet on the outer edge through both stitches:

R 07 sc, 26 x inc, sc



Cut and fasten the thread. Sew the opening in the middle of the backrest.



Finishing

Pin the backrest and sew it on your seat.
