Bathrobe and slippers

Crochet Pattern

Material:

- crochet hook size 2,5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr in blue and white
- sewing needle

Size: The bathrobe fits dog Murphy from the Mini Miami house

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round or row

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet
(or a dc, hdc ...) in each stitch

inc - make two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

dc – double crochet

dcdec – two stitches crochet together with a dc

rep - repeat until end of round

sl st - slip stitch

FLO – front loops only

sc with color change: change the color on this sc (when you make this single crochet stitch, grab the new color of your wool and pull it through the two loops on your hook).

Note:

The bathrobe is crocheted in rows. The three chain stitches after turning are counted as one dc. The bathrobe is made from bottom to top. The slippers are first crocheted in rounds and then in rows.

Bathrobe

26 x ch in color blue

R 01 25 x sc, turn **25**

R 02 3 x ch (first dc), 24 x dc, turn **25**

R 03 3 x ch (first dc), 24 x dc, turn **25**

R 04 3 x ch (first dc), 24 x dc, turn **25**

R 05 3 x ch (first dc), 24 x dc, turn **25**

R 06 3 x ch (first dc), 24 x dc, turn **25**

R 07 3 x ch (first dc), 4 x dc, 5 x ch, skip three stitches,
9 x dc, 5 x ch, skip three stitches, 5 x dc, ch, turn

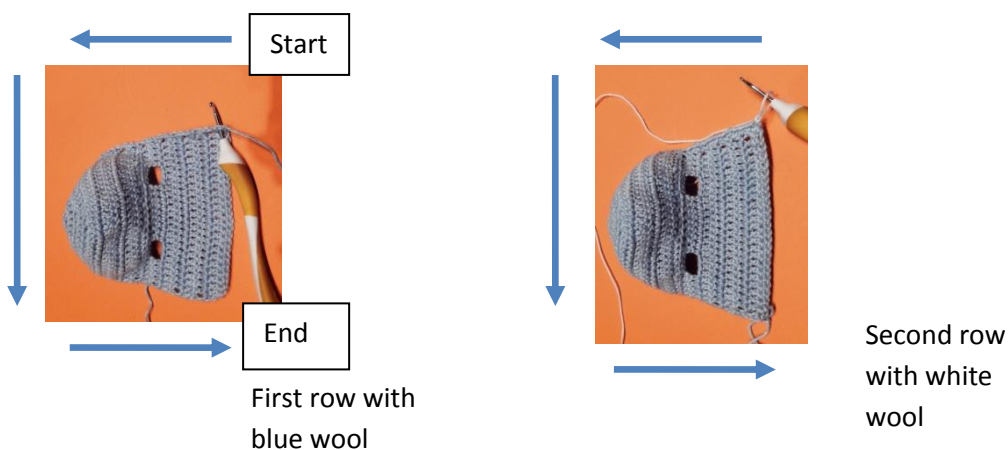
R 08 3 x ch (first dc), 4 x dc, 5 x sc (*crochet inside the chain and not around because the sleeves are crocheted onto the bathrobe*), 2 x dc,
2dcdec, dc, 2dcdec, 2 x dc, 5 x sc, 5 x dc, turn **27**

R 09	Here we start with the hood: FLO: 3 x ch (first dc), 4 x dc, 2dc, 5 x dc, 2dc, 3 x dc, 2dc, 5 x dc, 2dc, 5 x dc, turn	31
R 10	3 x ch (first dc), 30 x dc, turn	31
R 11	3 x ch (first dc), 9 x dc, 2dc, 9 x dc, 2dc, 10 x dc, turn	33
R 12	3 x ch (first dc), 15 x dc, 2dc, 16 x dc, turn	34
R 13	3 x ch (first dc), 33 x dc, ch, turn	34
R 14	10 x sc, 7 x dec, 10 x sc, turn	27
R 15	3 x ch (first dc), 26 x dc, ch, turn	27
R 16	7 x sc, 7 x dec, 6 x sc, turn	20
R 17	3 x ch (first dc), 19 x dc, ch, turn	20
R 18	10 x dec, ch, turn	10
R 19	Fold the hood (right side on right side) and crochet the sides together with 5 x sl st.	



Crochet around the bathrobe

Now crochet around the bathrobe with blue color. You need to make about 60 x sc. Then, with the color white crochet around again with 60 x sc. Make sure that you insert your hook inside the dc's and not around, because the stitches look better and you will not see any holes.



Sleeves (2 x)

Crochet the sleeves onto the bathrobe.



Start at the bottom of the arm cutout in the middle stitch and then crochet around in circles:

R 01	14 x sc crochet around in the stitches of the arm cutout, mark the rounds with a stitch marker	14
R 02	6 x sc, 2sc, 2sc, 6 x sc	16
R 03	sc in each stitch	16
R 04	sc in each stitch	16
R 05	sc in each stitch	16
R 06	sc with color change to white, 15 x sc	16
R 07	2 x sc, sl st, cut the thread and sew it	

Belt

46 x ch in color white, turn

45 x sl st, cut the thread and sew it

Pull the belt in the bathrobe: in the 4th row from the bottom, underneath a dc.



Slippers (2 x)

2 x ch in color blue

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from stitch	6
R 02	(sc, 2sc) x 3	9
R 03	sc in every stitch	9
R 04	(2 x sc, 2sc) x 3	12
R 05	sc in jede Masche	12
R 06	ch, turn: start now to <u>crochet in rows</u>	
	6 x sc, ch, turn	6
R 07	sc, 2 x dec, sc, ch, turn	4

R 08 2 x dec, ch, turn
R 09 skip first stitch, sl st
Sew the threads
