



Bathtub

Crochet Pattern

Material:

- crochet hook size 2,5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr in grey, white and blue and a small amount wool of red and darkblue
- Margarine box or similar plastic material, I have used an plastic folder
- Pipe cleaners
- fiberfill
- sewing needle, tapestry needle

Size: The bathtub has a height of 5 cm (1,97 inches) and a length of 12 cm (4,72 inches)

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round or row

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet
(or a dc, hdc ...) in each stitch

inc - make two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

dc – double crochet

dcinc – make two double crochet stitches in one stitch

hdc – half double crochet

hdcinc – make two half double crochet stitches in one stitch

rep - repeat all stitches until end of round

sl st - slip stitch

FLO – front loops only

sc with color change: change the color on this sc (when you make this single crochet stitch, grab the new color of your wool and pull it through the two loops on your hook).

Note:

Unless indicated otherwise, the parts are worked in rounds. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring. The rows should be marked with a thread.

Bottom of the bathtub (2 x)

13 x ch in color gray

R 01	inc in the second ch from hook and work around the chain (top), 10 x sc, 3 x sc in one stitch, continue working on the other side of the chain (bottom): 11 x sc	26
R 02	2 x inc, 10 x sc, 3 x inc, 10 x sc, inc	32
R 03	(sc, inc) x 2, 10 x sc, (sc, inc) x 3, 11 x sc, inc	38
R 04	(inc, 2 x sc) x 2, 10 x sc, (inc, 2 x sc) x 3, 10 x sc, inc, 2 x sc	44

R 05	(3 x sc, inc) x 2, 10 x sc, (3 x sc, inc) x 3, 13 x sc, inc	50
R 06	(inc, 4 x sc) x 2, 10 x sc, (inc, 4 x sc) x 3, 10 x sc, inc, 4 x sc	56

After you have crocheted the first bottom, cut the thread and sew it.

Place your crocheted bathtub bottom on the plastic material and draw around it with a pen, so you have the correct size. The cut out plastic material should be a little smaller than the crocheted tub bottom, so you don't have a problem to insert it between the two crocheted bottoms. You can also use a cardboard box, but then the bathtub is not waterproof 😊



Crochet now the second part and place both parts on each other, now start to crochet them together. Place the cut out plastic part in the middle before you finish this following round:

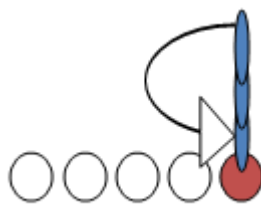
R 07	(5 x sc, inc) x 2, 10 x sc, (5 x sc, inc) x 3, 15 x sc, inc	62
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Now you should have a stable bathtub bottom

Continue to crochet in a circle for the Bathtub

R 08	(inc, 6 x sc) x 2, 10 x sc, (inc, 6 x sc) x 3, 10 x sc, inc, 6 x sc	68
R 09	(7 x sc, inc) x 2, 10 x sc, (7 x sc, inc) x 3, 17 x sc, inc	74
R 10 – R 15	sc in each stitch	74
R 16	33 x sc, 5 x hdc, hdcinc, 11 x dc, hdcinc, 5 x hdc, 18 x sc	76
R 17	33 x sc, 7 x hdc, 5 x dc, dcinc, 5 x dc, 7 x hdc, 17 x sc, sc with color change to blue	77
R 18	sc in each stitch	77
R 19	FLO: 76 x sc, sc with color change to white	77
R 20	76 x sc, sc with color change to blue	77
R 21	sc in each stitch	77
R 22	Last round:	

(sc, 3 x ch, now crochet in the first crocheted ch a sc, skip two stitches), repeat until the end of the round, cut the thread and sew it.



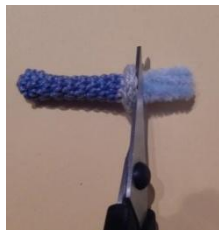
Legs (4 x)

2 x ch in color blue

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02 – R 10	sc in each stitch	6
R 11	sc with color change to gray, 5 x sc	6
R 12	6 x inc	12
R 13	12 x sl st	12

Cut the thread and sew it.

Crochet all four legs, place 2 pieces of pipe cleaner in each leg and roll them up.

**Water tap**

2 x ch in color blue

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	sc in each stitch	6
R 03	sc with color change to gray, 5 x sc	6
R 04	sc in each stitch	6
R 05	sc in each stitch	6
R 06	sc in each stitch	6
R 07	sc in each stitch	6
R 08	(sc, inc) x 3	9
R 09	sc in each stitch	9
R 10	sc in each stitch	9
R 11	5 x sc, 4 x sl st	9

Cut the thread and sew it, but don't close the opening in front, pull a piece of pipe cleaner inside the water tap

Turning handle (1 red and 1 dark blue)

2 x ch in color red or blue

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	(sc, inc) x 3	9
R 03	(dec, sc) x 2, dec, sc with color change to blue	6
R 04	sc in each stitch	6
R 05	sl st in each stitch	6

Cut the thread and sew it, stuff the turning handle with fiberfill

Bath tray

2 x ch in color blue

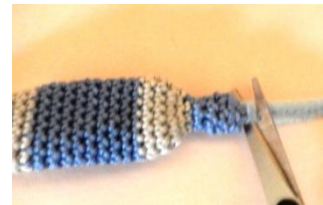
R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02 – R 05	sc in each stitch	6
R 06	sc with color change to gray, 5 x sc	6
R 07	inc x 6	12
R 08	(3 x sc, inc) x 3	15
R 09 + R 10	sc in each stitch	15
R 11	sc with color change to blue, 14 x sc	15
R 12 – R 20	sc in each stitch	15
R 21	3 x sc, sc with color change to gray, 11 x sc	15
R 22 + R 23	sc in each stitch	15
R 24	(3 x sc, dec) x 3	12
R 25	6 x dec	6
R 26	sc with color change to blue, 5 x sc	6
R 27 – R 30	sc in each stitch	6

sl st, cut the thread and sew it

Finishing

Bath tray:

Pull in a piece of pipe cleaner with a tapestry needle, cut off the ends.



Bathtub:

Attach the legs with pins to the bottom of the bathtub, check them again if they fit well and sew them on.



Bend the water tap, attach it to the edge of the bathtub with pins and sew it on.
Sew the turning handles on the right and left side of the water tap.



Have fun making the bathtub!

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
